Villa Collart

Villa Collart is located in the municipal park between the town hall and the "Al Schmelz" in Steinfort.

The history of Villa Collart is closely linked to the economic boom of the Municipality of Steinfort in the 19th and 20th centuries, which was based on steel production, the cement factories, and the brickworks of the Collart brothers. Villa Collart was built in 1904 as a double villa and served as the residence of the directors at the time. The villa and the property form a unique historical ensemble. In cooperation with the National Office for the Preservation of Historical Monuments, the villa and the park were classified as a national monument and placed under protection.

Villa Collart has been carefully renovated and transformed into a multifunctional public building with a restaurant including a sun terrace, an art gallery, meeting rooms and spaces for local associations.

In addition, civil weddings are held at Villa Collart.



Municipal rooms

Tourism

Hiking trails

Surrounded by large, unspoilt forests and cultivated fields, the Municipality of Steinfort is located in the west of the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg, close to the Belgian border, in one of the most varied natural landscapes in the country. Set in an idyllic setting at the gateway to the Eisch Valley, Steinfort is also the gateway to the Valley of the Seven Castles and offers numerous tourist opportunities to discover the authenticity of this remarkable region.

In collaboration with the Syndicat d'Initiative of Steinfort, the Municipality of Steinfort has marked five hiking trails on municipal land, inviting fellow citizens, hikers, and walkers to discover the municipality, its history, and its most important sights:

- Nature trail in Hagen and Grass
- Nature trails in Kleinbettingen
- Nature trails in Steinfort

In addition, there are other hiking and nature trails on the municipal territory and in the surrounding area, e.g.:

- The cross-border nature trail "Mirador", which starts at the Mirador Visitor Centre and leads the visitor through the nature reserve "Schwaarzenhaff" to the abbey of Clairefontaine.
- The hiking trail "Valley of the Seven Castles", which starts at Gäichel near Eischen and leads via Steinfort, follows the winding valley of the Eisch for 37km, rich in cultural treasures.

"Mirador" Nature and Forest Visitor Centre

The Mirador Visitor Centre is located on the former industrial site "Al Schmelz" in Steinfort. The building in which the visitor centre is located used to be part of the blast furnace plant and served as a platform for the loading crane. Today, the visitor centre is the gateway to the "Schwaarzenhaff" nature reserve and offers a lot of information about the flora, fauna, and local cultural heritage. The offices of the local forestry officer are also located in the centre.

Mirador offers you a wide range of activities, one more attractive than the other. Mirador's experienced animation team is happy to inform you and share their passion for a protected nature.

"Schwaarzenhaff" nature reserve

The "Schwaarzenhaff" area extends between the villages of Steinfort and Eischen. It is bordered to the south by the river Eisch, which also forms the border between the Grand Duchy and Belgium.

This area is part of the Natura 2000 site "Valley of the Mamer and the Eisch", which is the largest protected area of European interest in Luxembourg, covering an area of 6.797.60 ha. It includes two areas in need of special protection: the "Steekollen" near Steinfort and the quarries of the "Jongebësch" near Eischen. The nature reserve is rich in various habitat types, e.g. seminatural dry grasslands, floodplain forest, wet meadows and beech forests. Furthermore, it is a habitat for very rare species such as the midwife toads and bats.

Pond

After the "Schwarzenhaff" dam, which had been serving as a water reserve for the steel industry and for a short time to generate electricity, was abandoned in 1933, the inhabitants of Steinfort had to wait over 50 years until they once again had a standing body of water that could be used for recreational purposes.

Today, the pond in the heart of Steinfort is a popular place for walking, relaxing or fishing.

To fish in the Steinfort Pond, you need a permit issued by the Municipality of Steinfort.



Municipal park in Steinfort

The municipal park, classified as a national monument and under protection, connects the town hall and the "AI Schmelz" with Steinfort and forms a green oasis in the middle of the town centre. At the heart of the park is Villa Collart, which houses a restaurant, art gallery, meeting rooms, and spaces for local associations.

The park invites you to take walks and picnics along the watercourses of the Eisch. There is also a bookcase at your disposal, allowing you to borrow one or more books to be read on the spot or at home.

The "Unter der Berk" promenade zone & skate park

The "Unter der Berk" area was located between the steelworks and the foundry where it served as an intermediate storage area. In the post-war period, slag and excavated material were deposited here. In 1994, the area was redesigned according to ecological and landscape aspects.

Today, the Steinfort skate park is located within the "Unter der Berk" area and cultural activities take place there regularly.

Office régional du Tourisme Centre et Ouest du Luxembourg ("ORT Guttland")

The Office régional du Tourisme Centre et Ouest du Luxemboura (Regional Tourism Office Centre and West Luxembourg - ORT) brings together the main tourism stakeholders in a region to better coordinate activities and increase professionalism. The members of the ORT are composed of public, private and associative bodies. The ORT (and among others the LCTO - Luxembourg City Tourist Office) is a member of the national structure for the promotion of tourism ("Luxembourg for Tourism") and thus has the function of spokesperson for the region at national level.

The Guttland region, where the Municipality of Steinfort is located, represents an oasis of peace and quiet. Hundreds of kilometres of cycling and hiking trails make their loops through the unspoilt landscape of this nature and recreation area. The historical heritage is omnipresent, whether in the Valley of the Seven Castles, at the various Gallo-Roman sites or in the rural museums. The Guttland features a perfect symbiosis of old and new, which is reflected in the wide range of innovative and sustainable regional projects.

Cycle paths

Two cycle paths cross on the territory of the Municipality of Steinfort:

- PC12 the Attert track on the old railway line, coming from Linger and continuing to Colmar Berg,
- PC13 the track connecting to the circuit in the centre (Luxembourg City).

In addition, the Arlon BELAREL circuit is also accessible, either via the Eischen-Clairefontaine link or via the border at Steinfort-Sterpenich.

LEADER Lëtzebuerg West

LEADER is an initiative of the European Union and stands for "Liaison Entre Actions de Développement de l'Économie Rurale" (Link between Actions for the Development of the Rural Economy). According to this definition, the role of LEADER is to establish links between projects and economic actors in rural areas. The aim is to mobilise people in rural areas and help them develop their ideas and try out new methods.

The LEADER region Letzebuerg West has consisted of the Municipalities of Garnich, Habscht (part of Septfontaines), Helperknapp, Koerich, Mamer, Mersch and Steinfort since 2007. The area extends northwest of the city of Luxembourg in the form of a horseshoe from the Belgian border to the centre of the country. The area covers a surface of 181 km². The region is a largely homogeneous structure, which is a unit in particular due to its natural. cultural, economic and economic history.
